Members of the CIG requested a site visit to see the work at Hornsby Quarry and the M1 South Bound worksite. Construction Management agreed that it is safe for such a visit to take place and made arrangements to facilitate the visit on 21 August 2017.

WELCOME AND PREPARATIONS FOR SITE VISIT

1. CIG members met at the NorthConnex Pioneer Avenue Employee Transfer Facility in Thornleigh, where they were provided with Personal Protection Equipment including safety boots, high visibility vests, hard hats, safety glasses and gloves.
2. The Senior Safety Officer provided a safety briefing to the members.

SITE VISIT

1. CIG members travelled by bus to Hornsby Quarry where the Hornsby Site Manager provided a safety briefing to the members.
2. The Hornsby Quarry Site Manager provided an update on spoil management project.
3. CIG Members inspected the stock piles, conveyor belt and haul road.
4. CIG members then travelled to the M1 southbound to inspect the northern civil works including progress of the two-lane southbound road bridge, tunnel portals, construction of noise walls and retaining walls and preparations for traffic switch
5. The bus then returned CIG Members to the NorthConnex Pioneer Avenue Employee Transfer Facility in Thornleigh.
