UPDATE ON PROJECT CONSTRUCTION SURFACE WORK – NORTHERN VENTILATION OUTLET, M1 PACIFIC MOTORWAY WIDENING AND SOUTHBOUND BRIDGE, PEARCES CORNER AND HORNSBY QUARRY

- The CIG viewed a whole of project time-lapse video from the period between August to
 October and drone footage of the Southern Compound, Wilson Road Compound, Trelawney
 Street Compound, Pioneer Ave car park, Northern Compound, Pearces Corner, Bareena
 Avenue, the Northern Ventilation Outlet, M1 Pacific Motorway Widening and Hornsby Quarry
 and a time-lapse video of M1 Road Bridge (near Pearces Corner).
- Presentation on project construction surface work Northern Ventilation outlet, M1 Pacific Motorway widening and southbound bridge, Pearces Corner and Hornsby Quarry by the Operations Director
- 3. Questions and Comments
 - i. What is the depth of Cockle Creek?
 - The depth of Cockle Creek is between 0.5m 1m, depending on rainfall
 - ii. Is the plexiglass on the corner of Pennant Hills Road permanent?
 - Yes.
 - iii. A comment was made that plexiglass attracts graffiti
 - The project is aware of the risk of graffiti
 - iv. What is the purpose of the plexiglass
 - Plexiglass is used to retain sightlines and avoid overshadowing
 - v. Does the plexiglass affect pedestrian access to Hewitt Street from Pennant Hills Road?
 - vi. No. A gap in the plexiglass provides pedestrian access from the walkway from Pennant Hills Road to the Hewitt Avenue footpath.

PRESENTATION ON UPDATE ON TUNNELING – NORTHERN INTERCHANGE COMPOUND AND TRELAWNEY STREET COMPOUND

- Update on tunneling Northern Interchange compound and Trelawney Street compound by the Tunnel Construction Director
- 2. Questions and Comments
 - i. What spoil is currently going to fill Hornsby Quarry?
 - The majority of spoil is from tunneling, but spoil also comes from the project's civil sites
 - ii. How much spoil will go into Hornsby Quarry?
 - About 1 million banked cubic meters (BCM)
 - iii. What will be the final height of Hornsby Quarry when it is full?
 - The project will fill about one third of Hornsby Quarry.
 - Approximately 300,000 BCM spoil has gone into Hornsby Quarry to date.
