Temporary closure of Roper Lane access at Bridge Road Hornsby

Dear resident

As you are aware NorthConnex is undertaking site establishment work in Hornsby Quarry. This includes upgrading Bridge Road and widening the access road into the Quarry. This work will allow for up to one million cubic metres of spoil from NorthConnex work sites to be delivered to the Quarry. Once complete, Hornsby Shire Council plan to rehabilitate the site to provide a public recreational area for the local community.

In June and August 2016, we notified residents regarding the start of early work and site establishment, including an upgrade of Bridge Road.

To ensure the safety of local residents and to minimise impacts from truck delivery of spoil to Hornsby Quarry, there will be a change to local road access.

What are we doing?

To ensure trucks do not use Roper Lane to avoid the Bridge Road and Peats Ferry Road intersection, Roper Lane will be closed at Bridge Road from Wednesday 15 February 2017 until project completion planned for late 2018.

Roper Lane (north of the closure) will remain open, and access to properties will not be affected. Signage will be in place to advise motorists of changed traffic conditions.

Alternative access to Roper Lane

Access to Roper Lane will be via new permanent traffic lights at the intersection of Peats Ferry Road and Watson Avenue or via Summers Avenue.
