Update on day and night work: Installation of Intelligent Transport Systems on the Hills M2 corridor behind Coral Tree Drive and Carmen Drive and Hills M2 on-ramp at Pennant Hills Road

Dear resident

As part of ongoing work to build the NorthConnex tunnel exit and widen the Hills M2 Motorway, work to install Intelligent Transport Systems (ITS) services will be carried out within the Hills M2 corridor. This work will start from Wednesday 11 January 2017 and is expected to take six months to complete, weather permitting. A map of the work area is provided overleaf.

Intelligent Transport Systems (ITS) support the operation and control of the Hills M2 Motorway by providing power and vital information to assist with monitoring and managing traffic flow.

The majority of work will be carried out during standard construction hours between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays. To ensure the safety of motorists and workers and minimise traffic disruptions, some work on the Hills M2 on-ramp at Pennant Hills Road may be required at night. This work would be carried out between 8pm and 5am, Sunday to Thursday, and all impacted residents notified in advance of night work occurring.

The following activities will be carried out within the Hills M2 corridor behind Coral Tree Drive and Carmen Drive:

- > Installing access gates to the work site from the Hills M2 Motorway, Coral Tree Drive and Oakes Road
- > Clearing vegetation within the Hills M2 corridor
- > Excavating work including drainage relocation
- > Installing new ITS services including trenching work, installing conduit and cables and connecting and commissioning the new services
- > Disconnecting ITS services that are no longer required
- > Landscaping.

Plant and equipment for this work includes trucks, excavators, concrete trucks, water cart and light vehicles.

Access to the work site from Coral Tree Drive and Carmen Drive will be via Aiken Road and Oakes Road. Access to the Southern Compound for workers and vehicles will be required.

You may experience increased noise during some of these activities and we will make every effort to minimise impacts by:

- > Working during the day where possible
- > Notifying residents before night work starts near their property

- > Restricting high noise impact activities between 8am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm Saturday
- > Scheduling respite periods of one hour between high noise generating activities
- > Carrying out noise monitoring to ensure compliance with noise limits
- > Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- > Where possible directing noise generating equipment and lighting away from residential properties.

Traffic management and signage will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers.
