## **Night work: installation of CCTV and central messaging system on Pennant Hills Road, Normanhurst.**

Dear resident,

As part of the NorthConnex project, electronic message signs will be installed at key decision points for road users to provide information about travel times and conditions. A map of the work area is overleaf. This work will be carried out in stages and is expected to be completed by late August 2018. The technology is being installed to ensure tunnel safety and inform motorists about traffic conditions when the tunnel is operational.

Work will include:

- > Trenching work for power and telecommunications
- > Piling work for sign footings
- > Installing sign footings including drilling and pouring of concrete
- > Building new kerbs and general concrete works
- > investigate for services
- > backfilling and restoring the work area at the completion of each shift
- > connection to electricity, testing and completion work.

Plant and equipment for this work includes saws, hand held drills, jackhammers, excavators, dump trucks, compaction equipment, vacuum excavation truck, crane, piling equipment, concrete trucks, small excavator, and lighting towers.

To minimise impacts on traffic and to ensure the safety of workers and motorists, the majority of work will be carried out at night **between 9pm and 5am Sunday to Friday**. We will notify impacted residents in advance of work occurring. Where possible, some work will be done during standard construction hours of 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm Saturday. There will be no work carried out on Saturday nights. The bus stop on Pennant Hills Road will remain open during the work.

You may experience increased noise during some of these activities and we will make every effort to minimise impacts by:

- > turning off machinery when not in use
- > using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery
- > encouraging vehicles to park away from homes
- > monitoring noise to ensure compliance with noise limits
- > scheduling work to take place no more than two nights in a row and limiting work to no more than three nights in one week at the same location
- > ensuring that lighting is directed away from residences as much as practicable
- > coordinating respite for residents most affected by noise.
