NorthConnex construction: night work on Hills M2 Motorway

Further to our construction updates in the second half of 2015 and in January 2016, we would like to inform you about continuing night work activities for the Hills M2 Motorway integration work for NorthConnex.

The Hills M2 Motorway integration work is required to enable southbound traffic from the tunnel to merge safely with westbound traffic on the motorway. An additional westbound lane will be added between Pennant Hills Road and Windsor Road.

The following activities will continue to be carried out at a number of locations on the motorway between Pennant Hills Road and Windsor Road (see attached map):

- Construction of crossover points and related work next to the existing median
- Installation of safety barriers on the shoulder
- Installation of temporary street lights
- Installation of temporary line marking
- Installation of signs
- Asphalt repairs.

Work will be undertaken at night between **9pm and 5am** Sunday to Thursday, from **1 March 2016 to 28 April 2016**, weather permitting. Some **weekend work** will be scheduled and any directly impacted residents will be notified if required.

This work is required to be done at night due to the traffic volumes on the Motorway.

While the work will be done on the motorway, construction crews will use the compounds located on Eaton Road and Barclay Road between the hours of 7pm and 7am.

You are likely to experience increased noise during some of these activities and we will make every effort to minimise impacts by:

- Notifying residents and businesses before work starts near their property
- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- Where possible directing noise generating equipment away from residential properties

Work crews will be advised of the above mitigation measures.

Traffic management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. Variable message signs will be in place to advise of the changes to traffic conditions.

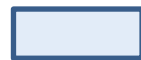


Map: Location of work activities along sections of the Hills M2 Motorway
