Day and night work: Service installation and pedestrian diversion work— Pennant Hills Road, Pearce Corner and Russell Avenue, Wahroonga

Dear Resident

Further to the January 2017 notification, night work will continue as part of the ongoing work to widen Pennant Hills Road at Wahroonga. The work will include installing new gas, water, stormwater, electricity and communication services under Pennant Hills Road, next to the Pearce Corner site compound. A map of the work area is provided in this notification.

Generally, work will be carried out during standard construction hours between **7am and 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **8am and 1pm on Saturday**, however for the safety of motorists and workers some work will be required at night.

Night work will be carried out between **9pm and 5am, Sunday to Friday** for **up to three nights per week**. There will be no work on Saturday nights. Directly impacted residents will be notified ahead of the work occurring and residents are encouraged to register for SMS updates by contacting us on 1800 997 057 or enquiries@northconnex.com.au.

This work is expected to be complete by December 2017, weather permitting.

Pedestrian footpath closure

To carry out this work safely the pedestrian footpath on the northbound side of Pennant Hills Road will remain closed between Russell Avenue and Pacific Highway, and pedestrians will continue to be diverted to the footpath on the southbound side of Pennant Hills Road between Aaron Place and the Pacific Highway. Traffic management and signage is in place to ensure the safety of pedestrians and workers.

The main work activities include:

- > service investigation work
- > excavation and trenching
- > removal of a median on Pennant Hills Road
- > installation of services including gas, water, stormwater, electricity and communication
- > asphaltting and pavement work.

Plant and equipment includes a crane, light vehicles, lighting towers, vacuum truck, generators, excavators, trucks, rollers, concrete trucks, street sweeper, water cart, concrete saws and hand tools.

Managing impacts

You will experience noise during this work and we will make every effort to minimise impact by:

- > consulting directly affected residents
- > using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- > turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- > using solar-powered lighting tower
- > not working more than three nights a week and no more than two nights consecutively for noisy work.

Traffic management

As part of this work, there will be night closures of two northbound lanes on Pennant Hills Road between the Pacific Highway and Russell Avenue. The closures will take place between **9pm and 5am, Sunday to Friday for up to three nights per week**, weather permitting. Traffic changes, management and signage will be in place for the safety of motorists, residents and workers.
