Night work: M1 Pacific Motorway widening, Wahroonga

Dear resident

As part of the M1 Pacific Motorway widening, work is continuing to build the northbound tunnel exit ramp, southbound tunnel entry ramp, northern ventilation outlet and noise walls at Wahroonga.

This work is carried out on the M1 and adjacent to the motorway between Alexandria Parade Bridge and 700 metres north of Edgeworth David Avenue, Wahroonga. A map of the area is included.

Generally, the work is carried out during standard construction hours between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturday however to ensure the safety of motorists and workers, some of this work is carried out at night.

Night work is carried out between 9pm and 5am Sunday to Friday. No work is carried out on Saturday nights. We will notify directly impacted residents before the start of night work. Workers and vehicles access the Junction Road construction compound 24 hours a day.

This work includes:

- installing temporary barriers and line marking to provide a safe working area
- removing existing noise walls and installing temporary and permanent noise walls to reduce the noise impacts
- tree trimming, tree and vegetation removal along the shoulders of the motorway and behind the existing noise walls
- demolition, excavation and earthworks
- relocating and installing services including water, drainage and electrical
- piling work including excavating, pouring concrete, trimming piles, drilling anchors and backfilling
- installing soil nails (ground supports) and shotcreting
- concreting, asphaltting and saw cutting
- installing signs and landscaping
- maintenance and inspection activities.

Plant and equipment for this work includes cranes, excavators, piling rigs, tunnel boring machines, surface profilers, heavy and light vehicles, lighting towers, generators, scaffold, rattle guns, hammer drills, grinders, chainsaws, mulchers, rollers, bob cats, concrete trucks, street sweepers, water carts and pumps, elevated work platforms, concrete saws and pumps, core drills, line marking and removal plant, and hand tools.
