UPDATE NorthConnex construction: night work on Hills M2 Motorway

Further to our October and November 2015 construction updates we would like to inform you about continuing night work activities in preparation for the Hills M2 Motorway integration work for NorthConnex.

The Hills M2 Motorway integration work is required, to enable southbound traffic from the tunnel to merge safely with westbound traffic on the motorway. An additional westbound lane will be added between Pennant Hills Road and Windsor Road.

The following activities will continue to be carried out at a number of locations on the motorway between Pennant Hills Road and Windsor Road (see attached map):

- Construction of drainage pits, crossover points and related work next to the existing median
- Installation of safety barriers on the shoulder.

Work will be carried out **at night between 9pm and 5am** for five nights each week from **10 January 2016 to 29 February 2016**, weather permitting. This work is required to be done at night due to the traffic volumes on the motorway.

Weekend work will be carried out from 15 to 17 January 2016. Other weekend work for the Hills M2 Motorway will be scheduled and any impacted residents will be notified if required.

While the work will be carried out on the motorway, construction crews will continue to use the Southern Interchange compound located between Eaton Road and the Hills M2 Motorway between the hours of 7pm and 7am.

Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work.

Traffic management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. Variable message signs will be in place to advise of the changes to traffic conditions.

We apologise for any inconvenience and will take steps to minimise any impact associated with this important work.

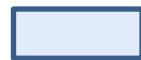


Map: Location of work activities along sections of the Hills M2 Motorway
