## Day and night work: Service installation and pedestrian diversion work – Pearces Corner, Wahroonga

Dear resident,

Further to the June 2017 notification, night work will continue as part of ongoing work to widen Pennant Hills Road at Wahroonga. The work will include installing water, stormwater, electricity and communication services under Pennant Hills Road, next to the Pearces Corner site compound. A map of the work area is provided in this notification.

Generally, work will be carried out during standard construction hours between **7am and 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **8am and 1pm on Saturday**, however for the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers some work will be required at night.

Night work will be carried out between **9pm and 5am, Sunday to Friday** for **up to three nights per week**. There will be no work on Saturday nights or public holidays. Directly impacted residents will be notified ahead of the work occurring and residents are encouraged to register for SMS updates by contacting us on 1800 997 057 or enquiries@northconnex.com.au.

This work is expected to be complete by February 2018, weather permitting.

### Pedestrian diversion

To continue to carry out this work safely, a temporary pedestrian diversion will be in place from Wednesday 11 October for about three weeks, weather permitting. The pedestrian footpath on the northbound side of Pennant Hills Road will remain closed between Russell Avenue and Pacific Highway.

During this time pedestrians will not be able to cross Pennant Hills Road near the Pacific Highway. Pedestrians will be directed to use the footpath on the southbound side of Pacific Highway accessed via the pedestrian crossing near Woolcott Avenue. We anticipate this detour will take an additional 10 minutes.

Following the temporary pedestrian diversion the existing pedestrian diversion arrangements will remain in place until work is complete. Traffic management and signage will be in place to ensure the safety of pedestrians and workers. A map of the work area and pedestrian diversion routes is provided with this notification.

The main work activities include:

- > service investigation work
- > excavation and trenching

- > removal of a median on Pennant Hills Road
- > installation of services including water, stormwater, electricity and communication
- > asphaltting and pavement work.

Plant and equipment includes a crane, light vehicles, lighting towers, vacuum truck, generators, excavators, trucks, rollers, concrete trucks, street sweeper, water cart, concrete saws and hand tools.

### **Managing impacts**

You will experience noise during this work and we will make every effort to minimise impact by:

- > consulting directly affected residents
- > using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- > turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- > using solar-powered lighting towers
- > not working more than three nights a week and no more than two nights consecutively for noisy work.

### **Traffic management**

As part of this work, there will be night closures of two northbound lanes on Pennant Hills Road between the Pacific Highway and Russell Avenue. The closures will take place between **9pm and 5am, Sunday to Friday for up to three nights per week**, weather permitting. Traffic management and signage will be in place for the safety of motorists, residents and workers.
