Southern Interchange Compound: 24 hour power substation relocation over the Easter long weekend - Friday 14 to Monday 17 April 2017

Dear resident,

As part of ongoing work to carry out 24 hour tunnelling activities and build permanent NorthConnex structures, work will be carried out over the Easter long weekend to relocate the power substation within the Southern Interchange Compound at West Pennant Hills.

This work will include connecting cables, transporting the substation to the new location within the compound, installing fencing around the substation and testing cables.

The substation relocation is required to take place during this period when the power can be switched off inside the compound during the tunnel shut down period over the Easter long weekend.

Plant and equipment includes cranes (various sizes), light vehicles, elevated work platform, generator, telehandler, hand tools and battery drills.

Our work may be noisy but we will make every effort to minimise impact by:

- consulting with directly affected residents
- locating the generator in the shaft within the acoustic shed
- carrying out high noise impact activities during day shifts
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- carrying out night work activities inside a container and limiting use of plant or power tools
- completing work behind site hoardings, with an additional hoarding to be constructed around the new substation.
