Night work survey and service investigations for the installation of permanent road signage for NorthConnex - Beecroft Road, Beecroft

NorthConnex is a nine kilometre tunnel that will link the M1 Pacific Motorway at Wahroonga to the Hills M2 Motorway at West Pennant Hills, removing around 5,000 trucks off Pennant Hills Road.

Lendlease Bouygues Joint Venture has been awarded the contract to design and deliver the work.

Please be advised that night work activities will need to take place in your area on Beecroft Road for about 3 weeks starting 19 October 2015.

What are we doing?

As part of the ongoing work for NorthConnex, the project team will be carrying out site investigations to determine the location for the installation of road signage for NorthConnex. The survey investigations and potholing work will take place at Beecroft Road in Beecroft and will take around 2 weeks to complete including day work.

Work will include the following activities:

- Surveying to identify land boundaries
- Searching for locations of utility services which involves opening up the road, footpath or verge to locate the service
- Marking up located services and utilities in different colours

The location of the work is indicated on the map overleaf.

You will be provided with advance notice of work outside your property which will generally be at night to avoid disruption to traffic. Some work will be done during the day.

Plant and equipment for this work includes but is not limited to saws, hand held drill, vacuum truck, and generators.

You are likely to experience increased noise during some of these activities and we will make every effort to minimise impacts by:

- Notifying residents and businesses before work starts near their property
- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- Where possible directing noise generating equipment away from residential properties
- Work crew will all be advised of the above mitigation measures.
