Dear Resident,

Night work: power connection – Pearces Corner, Wahroonga

As part of the Pearces Corner Compound site establishment, the NorthConnex project team needs to connect a new power source to the compound located on the corner of the M1 Pacific Highway and Pennant Hills Road.

This work will start on 11 April 2016 and is expected to be completed in one night. This work needs to be carried out at night to minimise traffic disruption.

What are we doing?

The work includes moving a power pole on site at Pearces Corner and connecting it to an existing power pole on the corner of the intersection of Pacific Highway and Pennant Hills Road. The cable connecting the two poles will be moved across the southbound and northbound traffic lanes of Pennant Hills Road by qualified members of the project team using an elevated work platform. Traffic will need to be temporarily halted for up to five minutes around midnight while this takes place.

Plant and equipment to be used includes:

- Two solar powered light towers
- Two traffic attenuator trucks
- Crane
- Utility vehicle
- Elevated work platform.

Managing noise

You may experience noise during the work, however we will make every effort to minimise impacts by:

- Scheduling the noisiest work to occur before midnight, where possible
- Equipment, machinery and vehicles to be turned off when not in use
- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- Solar lights will be directed away from any nearby residents.

Temporary traffic arrangements

Pennant Hills Road northbound and southbound slow lanes will be closed between 9.00pm and 5.00am, weather permitting. Traffic will need to be temporarily halted for up to five minutes at the Pearces Corner intersection with the Pacific Highway. This will allow for the new power line to be moved by an elevated work platform from one side of Pennant Hills Road to the other. This activity is anticipated to happen at about midnight.



In the event of bad weather, work will need to be rescheduled and will occur on the following night, XX April, 2016.
