Widening of the Darling Mills Creek Bridge

From April 2016, work to widen the Darling Mills Creek Bridge on the Hills M2 Motorway will begin and will take up to 18 months to complete. This work needs to be undertaken to allow for the construction of an additional westbound lane on the Hills M2 Motorway between Pennant Hills Road and Windsor Road.

Site establishment work at the Darling Mills Creek Bridge will start on 18 April 2016 and will take approximately 8 weeks to complete, weather permitting.

Work activities

Site establishment activities include:

- Surface investigations to locate the sewer main
- Tree pruning of the Murri-Yanna track and Darling Mills Creek Reserve in preparation for widening activities
- Fencing the work area to maintain pedestrian access on the track
- Stabilisation of the track including pad footing and a footing for the tower crane

Once the work site is established, construction activities to widen the Darling Mills Creek Bridge will continue. Access to the site for construction will be via the Hills M2 Motorway as required, with limited access for movement of equipment via Ventura Road.

Equipment and plant to be used includes:

- Excavators
- Compressors
- Compactor
- Generator
- Rollers
- Water cart
- Piling rig
- Tower crane
- Hand tools
- Concrete vibrators
- Trucks.

The majority of the work will be carried out during standard construction hours from **7am to 6pm on weekdays** and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**. Some work may be required at night and on weekends due to traffic volumes on the bridge. These activities will be kept at a minimum and all impacted residents will be notified in advance of work occurring.

Murri-Yanna track

During initial site establishment at the Darling Mills Creek Bridge, the Murri-Yanna track will remain open to track users. Traffic controllers will be in place to manage and maintain the safety of pedestrians passing the work site. The Murri-Yanna track will
