Delivery of excavators – night works and lane closures

NorthConnex is a nine kilometre tunnel that will link the M1 Pacific Motorway at Wahroonga to the Hills M2 Motorway at West Pennant Hills, removing around 5,000 trucks off Pennant Hills Road.

Lend Lease Bouygues Joint Venture has been awarded the contract to design and deliver the work.

What are we doing?

In preparation for the establishment of the southern interchange compound on Pennant Hills Road the project team will be removing the existing buildings and structures such as sheds, swimming pools and internal fences, from properties located between 608-618 and 628-640 Pennant Hills Road. These properties were acquired by Roads and Maritime Services for NorthConnex.

Delivery of temporary buildings

Prior to the removal of existing buildings and structures, temporary site buildings will be delivered to the site as worker accommodation. This will include a portable toilet, site shed, tool shed and generator.

Delivery of temporary buildings - work hours

Work will be carried out from 10am to 4pm on 20 April, weather permitting. We will notify you in advance if there will be any changes to this time.

Delivery of temporary buildings - temporary traffic changes

One lane of the shoulder of Copeland Road and Eaton Road will be closed and traffic control will be in place. Traffic management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. This will include temporary diversion of the delivery and stop/slow traffic arrangements staffed by traffic management personnel on local roads.

Delivery of excavators

Two 30 tonne excavators will be delivered to site prior to the removal of the buildings. To minimise disruption to traffic the delivery will take place at night between 9.30pm and midnight on 20 April. The excavators will be delivered by two trucks with trailers and will park on Pennant Hills Road as the excavators are removed from the trailers and delivered onto the site.

- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- Ensure there is not impact on access to driveways.

Delivery of excavators - work hours

Work will be carried out from 9.30pm to midnight on 20 April, weather permitting. We will notify you in advance if there will be any changes to this time.

Delivery of excavators - temporary traffic changes

Two left hand northbound lanes on Pennant Hills Road will be closed and traffic control will be in place. The speed limit on the open lane will be reduced to 60km/h.

Appropriate traffic and safety management procedures including traffic control to assist the excavator delivery will be put in place. There will be no impact on access to driveways.

We apologise for any inconvenience and will take steps to minimise any impact associated with this important work.
