Night work installation of new concrete slab on western footpath of Pennant Hills Road, Pennant Hills

Please be advised some night work activities will need to take place on Pennant Hills Road, Pennant Hills for around three nights starting **Sunday 8 November 2015**.

What are we doing?

A concrete slab will be installed in the western footpath of Pennant Hills Road, Pennant Hills to protect the existing services adjacent to the Wilson Road Compound site (refer to map overleaf for work area). This will also allow construction of a dedicated truck access to the compound site from Pennant Hills Road and will reduce the need for trucks to use local roads.

Work activities include:

- Setting up traffic controls and safety barriers
- Saw cutting segments of the existing concrete footpath
- Removing cut segments of the path
- Excavating and installing a new concrete slab
- Reinstating the footpath and removing the traffic controls.

Plant and equipment used for this work includes an excavator, vacuum trucks, concrete vibrators, saw cutters, traffic control vehicles, generator and lighting towers.

You are likely to experience increased noise during some of these activities and we will make every effort to minimise impacts by:

- Sequencing particularly noisy work so they occur:
 - before midnight (where possible)
- Placing noise blankets on saw cutting machinery
- Turning off machinery when not in use
- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery.

The NorthConnex project team has been in ongoing consultation with residents in the area and will meet with impacted residents to discuss night work.
