Night work: road sign installation, barrier installation, scaffold installation and tree clearing, Pennant Hills Road, Thornleigh

Please be advised some night work activities will need to take place on Pennant Hills Road, Thornleigh between Nelson Street and The Comenarra Parkway for eight nights starting Wednesday 9 December 2015 (refer to map overleaf for location of work activities).

What are we doing?

As part of ongoing site establishment work for the Trelawney Street Compound, the project team will be carrying out the following activities to provide a dedicated truck access to and from the site on Pennant Hills Road.

Installation of road signs

The project team will be installing about 20 road work warning signs along Pennant Hills Road, Thornleigh between The Comenarra Parkway and Nelson Street.

Plant and equipment used for this work includes two vacuum trucks, lighting towers, a street sweeper and traffic control vehicles.

This work will take one-two night, weather permitting.

Installation of traffic barriers

Traffic barriers will be installed on top of the existing kerb line along Pennant Hills Road.

Plan and equipment for this work includes a crane, semi-trailer trucks, a generator, lighting towers as well as traffic control vehicles.

This work will take two nights, weather permitting.

Scaffolding installation

Scaffolding will be installed in front of a property acquired for the project at 217 Pennant Hills Road prior to removing the building as part of the compound site establishment.

Plant and equipment for this work includes a forklift, circular saw, a grinder, scaffolding materials, lighting trucks and traffic control vehicles.

Clearing trees and grass cutting

Trees will be cleared along the fence line of two properties at 225 and 227 Pennant Hills Road, which have been acquired for the project. The grass will also be cut on the nature strip outside of these properties.

Plant and equipment used for this work include chainsaws, lawn mower, tree climbers and lighting towers as well as traffic control vehicles.

This work will take one night to complete, weather permitting. You are likely to experience increased noise during some of the activities and we will make every effort to minimise impacts by:

- Sequencing particularly noisy work so they occur before midnight (where possible)
- Placing noise blankets on saw cutting machinery
- Turning off machinery when not in use
- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery.

The NorthConnex team has been consulting with residents and will continue meet with impacted residents to discuss night work. After the first night of work, the project team will carry out a noise check with residents and assist with any concerns or issues.

Hours of work

Night work activities will be carried out between 9pm to 5am Sunday to Thursday nights.

Temporary traffic arrangements

This work will involve the closure of two southbound slow lanes on Pennant Hills Road. The road sign installation work will also require the temporary closure of the northbound fast lane on Pennant Hills Road. To minimise impact on motorists, work will occur outside peak times between 9pm and 5am.
