Dear Resident,

Night work: concrete coring and services investigations on Pennant Hills Road and Pacific Highway, Wahroonga

Please be advised of night work activities on Pennant Hills Road, Wahroonga starting on Tuesday 22 February 2016. These works are expected to continue until 22 March, weather permitting, with work occurring three nights per week (excluding Friday and Saturday nights).

What are we doing?

Further to our notification issued on 28 December 2015, service investigations are continuing. The road surface will be sawcut in 20 locations on Pennant Hills Road, Pacific Highway, Russell Avenue and Aaron Place to provide additional information on underground service locations for the final design of the north and southbound lanes of Pennant Hills Road at Pearces Corner (refer to map overleaf).

Plant and equipment used for this work includes lighting towers, a concrete saw, a vacuum truck, a tipper truck, traffic management trucks, light vehicles and hand tools.

During these night work activities, you will experience some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by:

- Where possible completing noisier work earlier in the evening
- Turning off machinery when not in use
- Setting up temporary noise shielding around coring activities
- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- Parking away from homes
- Noise monitoring to ensure compliance with noise limits
- Scheduling work to take place no more than two nights in a row and three nights in one week at the same location
- Offering respite to residents most affected by the noise.

Night work activities will be carried out between 10.30pm to 5am to minimise traffic disruption.
